Dear Parent,

Greetings of the day!

We are a school affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and as per the directives received from board vide circular no. **CBSE/SO(PTG)/2018** dated **31.01.2019** (published on the CBSE website) the school is providing the following instructions to our Grade X students and parents for **strict compliance**. The same circular has been uploaded on the school website for your ready reference.

- I. No Candidate would be allowed to enter the Examination Centre after 10:00 am under any circumstances. Hence Parents to ensure that the student must reach before time.
- II. The Candidate should report for the examination in complete **school uniform and with school Identity Card** in addition to Admit Card issued by CBSE and permissible stationery items only.
- III. The Candidate must visit the Examination Centre at least one day prior to the date of examination, so that they can reach before 10:00 am on all the days of the examination.
- IV. The Candidate should leave for the Examination Centre keeping in view the weather conditions, traffic conditions etc.
- V. The Candidate and Mother/Father/Guardian must check the particulars mentioned in the **Admit Card** and sign at the appropriate place after verifying particulars including photograph and its correctness.
- VI. The Candidate should not carry **Mobile or any electronic items and all other barred items** to the Examination Centre.
- VII. The Candidate must read and adhere to the important instructions given in the **Admit Card**.
- VIII. The Candidate must read the amended rules for unfair practices and its consequences.
- IX. The Candidate and Parent/Guardian should refrain themselves from spreading rumours and posting any material on social websites including **WhatsApp, You Tube, Twitter etc.**

It may be noted that a lot of precaution is being carried out by the CBSE Centre and Schools to ensure **Zero Error** in conducting of examination and its processes post that. Kindly note, in case of non-adherence to any of the guidelines mentioned above, the Board is likely to take very strict action against the student concerned and the school shall not be held responsible for the same. These instructions are also made available on the CBSE website.
