Greetings from Amanora School!

With the advent of monsoon season, it is essential to ensure that our students are well prepared to stay safe and enjoy the rainy days ahead. The monsoon brings its share of delights and challenges including many health issues, especially for school going children. The probability of fever, respiratory infections, fungal infections, and abdominal infections increases. Equipping our children with the necessary knowledge and tools can make a significant difference. From rain gear and hygiene practices to indoor activities and safety precautions, there are numerous ways to ensure your wards will have a joyful and secure monsoon experience.

We as school are concerned about the kind of rain gear being used by our students on campus. It has been observed that most of the students are carrying umbrellas to protect themselves from the onslaught of showers. Usage of umbrellas in school space can be hazardous. Students may accidentally poke or injure themselves or others with the umbrella's sharp edges or pointed ends. Umbrellas can also obstruct vision, leading to accidents and collisions, especially in areas during school dispersal. The extended canopy of an umbrella may take up valuable space and can be disruptive during movement. Wet umbrellas can drip water, potentially damaging books. Leaving umbrellas to dry in classrooms or other shared spaces can create a mess and lead to slipping hazards.

Raincoats provide a safer rain gear, as they do not have any sharp edges or pointed parts that could cause injury. They allow for better visibility and freedom of movement, reducing the risk of accidents. Besides providing full body, coverage raincoats are compact and can be easily folded or stored in a bag when not in use.

Encouraging students to use raincoats promotes their safety and reduces potential risks in the school environment. Even during commuting through buses or other modes of transportation students may not have adequate space for usage of an umbrella. Opening and closing umbrellas in crowded vehicles can be dangerous and may cause inconvenience to other students.

It is advised that Amanora School students should avoid usage of umbrellas on campus and instead use raincoats for better protection, easier mobility, and minimal chances of accidents.
