Dear Parents

Please note that as per the directives of the Maharashtra State GR no. 20090204171407001, Marathi has been introduced as a compulsory language in all English Medium Schools. Hence we are liable to introduce Marathi as a subject from the academic session 2020-2021. Till 2019-2020 Sanskrit along with Hindi and Marathi was one of the options for the 3rd language. However, with the introduction of **Marathi as a compulsory language** it is not feasible to continue with Sanskrit. Hence it will be discontinued as a language option in a phased out manner. Kindly note the plan of action for this transition.

- Marathi will be introduced in Grade I, II and III with effect from academic session 2020-2021.
- Marathiwill be the only option in grades IV, V, and VI from academic session 2020-2021 and Sanskrit language will be dropped as an option.
- Grade IV and V students who had Sanskrit as an option in the academic session 2019-2020
 will be provided with extra guidance and bridge program to match up the grade level
 competency.
- Students who had opted for Sanskrit in Grade VI and VII in 2019 -2020 will continue with Sanskrit as an option till 2022-2023 or when they pass out from Grade VIII, whichever is earlier
- Book vendors have been notified about the changes and details of requisite books are shared.

Scheme of Studies and Plan of Assessment for Marathi will be as follows:-
