Dear Parents

Greetings from Amanora School!

“Discipline is the key to achievement.”

There are so many distractions in the contemporary world that can divert a student from his primary goal. When a student stays disciplined, it's easier for him or her to remain on top of things. All children have the potential to learn and succeed and all children deserve an enabling environment to do so.

Students, parents, and school staff all have a role in making schools safe and must work together to achieve this goal. We firmly believe that school alone cannot do enough to inculcate the right set of values amongst students and that is where the role of parents, especially of young children becomes more paramount.

In order to instill in our students the importance of self-discipline, punctuality and time management we have taken the decision of **closing the gate at 7:30 am** with due deliberation. And we are indeed very grateful to all the parents who have supported us in driving this through as the late coming has almost become negligible.

All students, regardless of grades, at Amanora School are engaged in discussion of the school community's expectations and are active participants in creating classroom **“ground rules”** for their behavior. School staff keeps parents informed of their child's behavior and engages parents as partners in addressing areas of concern. To ensure that parents are able, encouraged, and supported to become active and involved partners in promoting a safe, supportive school environment, they should be familiar with the **School Code**.

I urge the parents to once again go through School Diary to familiarize themselves thoroughly with the School Code. I also seek earnest support in driving across certain important tenets of our **Discipline Policy** with the seriousness that they demand. **Page 13 of School Diary** explicitly displays a list of **prohibited items** that all the students are forbidden to bring. These items either constitute a threat to the physical/moral safety of others or distraction to the academic focus of the fellow students in the school. These prohibitions apply to the school campus and school buses as well. Eventuality of a serious misconduct on part of a student will attract a **Disciplinary Action**, the sequential procedure of which is shared on **page 8 of the diary**. This should be read thoroughly by the student so as to act responsibly and be aware of the consequences an irresponsible behavior will lead to.

The school expects full co-operation of the parents and guardians in all matters, concerning their child's education. Do check the School Diary every evening and make note of the remarks if any in the Diary by the Principal or the teacher and sign. Please ensure the child comes neatly dressed to school and encourage him/her to keep the personal belongings carefully. Parents are requested to refer to the school calendar to avoid taking the child out for social functions and other gatherings, during school working days. Kindly be aware of the obligations under POCSO Act for the care and wellbeing of your child. Parents will not be allowed to bring the tiffin for their wards during school hours. School culture and climate have a profound impact on students' academic progress and their relationships with peers and adults. Amanora School continually strives to promote a positive school culture that provides students with a supportive environment in which they grow socially emotionally and academically.
