Eligibility Criteria to apply for the Junior School Cabinet:

- Student should have scored 90% and above marks in AY 2023-2024.
- Student should have more than 90% attendance in AY 2023-2024.
- Student should have scored more than 70 points in IAAA in AY 2023-2024.
- Student should not have any discipline-related complaints in AY 2023-2024

Important Dates:

- Nominations to be filled in by 25th June 2024.
- Shortlisted nominations will be announced on 26th June 2024 based on Personal Interview and Eligibility Criteria
- Campaigning speech by shortlisted candidates in the assembly on 27th June 2024
- Panel Interview on 28th June 2024
- Announcement of Junior School Cabinet on 1st July 2024
