Dear Parents

At the outset we would like to extend our heartfelt gratitude towards all the support and feedback rendered to us since inception. It has enabled us to scale great heights of achievement in such a short span of time. We have come a long way from being a single storeyed school of 12 classes to a multi-storeyed, state-of-the-art structure that houses over 100 digital class rooms, 4 fully equipped laboratories, special Dance, Music, Art, Library and Yoga rooms, 2 Computer labs and a well-equipped Innovations lab. In addition to the above for various Sports activities we have a FIFA certified Astro turf, a basket-ball court, indoor table tennis court and much more. All these facilities are provided to the 2800 plus students of the school.

Our in-school activities are planned to inculcate strong values and beliefs which will benefit the students in their future life. The safety and welfare of the students is of predominant importance to us as our School Culture is weaved around it. We try to keep up with latest trends for securing the students welfare, good health and safety. Our school is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and the affiliation will come up for renewal in 2021. We have three brilliant Grade X results under our belt and are gearing up rapidly for the fourth one. Our school events like Tirangaa, the Inter-School National Level Quiz and Annual Days are very well appreciated and aimed to encourage maximum student participation. We have worked real hard to establish good parent-school connect through various medium.

We would like to place on records that ours is a permanently unaided school which functions purely on the funds collected by means of **school fee**. The school abides by all the State Education laws of Maharashtra as well as the CBSE guidelines laid out by the Central Board of Secondary Education and has a very judiciously elected SMC-School Management Committee (comprising of parent representatives) and a fairly nominated EPTA – Executive Committee of Parent Teacher Association (elected annually) that provides guidance in the smooth functioning of the School. The school fee has been proposed, deliberated and signed-off by both the SMC and EPTA members before it is rolled out to the parents. Our school does not take any Capitation fee and issues a proper receipt against every fee payment received by us.

The school has always been sensitive and supportive towards parent concerns and issues which lead to severe delay and staggered fee collection over the years. The need for sharing a **Definite Fee Policy** was therefore felt as you will appreciate that in the absence of funds, the day-to-day functioning of the school gets hampered. Please note that we have two terms in every academic session however, for the convenience of the parents we have provided 3 installments to remit the fee with deadlines being 10th April, 10th October and 10th January respectively for each academic session.

Going forward in the event of the fee not being paid by the deadline, a fine of **rupees 5 per day will be levied for two months**. If the fee instalment is still not paid, the school will assume that the parent exhibits an intent of not wanting to or unwillingness to continue the admission of his ward with the school and hence could lead to the name of the student being struck off from the records of the school. This policy will be enforced with effect from 10th October 2017 (the deadline for payment of second instalment). Hence in order to take our collective goal of providing a conducive environment for holistic development of our children it becomes imperative not only for the school but also for the parents to honour our partnership and we request you to cooperate with us. Looking forward to serving you better at all times.
