Step 3: Pay course fee latest by 5th May 2021


Upon completion of the registration process and payment of fee, Skillsphere will share Zoom meeting details latest by 8th May 2021.

Session Details for the Summer Skills Fest

Day	Event/Training	Time	Details
Day 1 - 10th May	MUN Oriented Training and Skill Set Development	3 hrs (11:00am to 2:00pm including 2 breaks of 15 mins each)	This session introduces students to the world of Model United Nations. After a fun ice-breaker and introduction activity, students learn about the UN's structure and basics of UNA/USA MUN Procedure. This session also involves engaging discussions on countries of the world
Day 2 - 11th May	Model UN Simulation	3 hrs (11:00am to 2:00pm including 2 breaks of 15 mins each)	Day 2 of the workshop is dedicated to a full-fledged MUN simulation during which all skills taught on Day 1 are put to test. Beyond this, students participate in a 'Global Village' session during which they share fun facts about the country they are representing
Day 3 - 12th May	Amazing Indian Race	3 hrs (11:00am to 2:00pm including 2 breaks of 15 mins each)	On Day 3, the focus of the workshop shifts to national awareness. Students learn about a range of facets related to India including its current affairs, basic history, military, soft power etc. through a fun virtual treasure hunt called the Amazing Indian Race with skill set development activities and checkpoints
Day 4 - 13th May	Utopian Parliament	3 hrs (11:00am to 2:00pm including 2 breaks of 15 mins each)	Session 4 of the Summer Skills Fest provides students with an opportunity to step into the shoes of parliamentarians and solve different national issues. This is done through an interesting simulation called the 'Utopian Parliament' which is free of political parties
Day 5 - 14th May	Debate Training and Competition	3 hrs (11:00am to 2:00pm including 2 breaks of 15 mins each)	The final day of the Summer Skills Fest focuses on training students for the popular Bombay Style of debate. Students learn the basics of public speaking, debating and thereafter participate in full-fledged debates. The session ends with comprehensive feedback being provided to every participant.
